RULES FOR PARENTS PICK UP AND DROP OFF STUDENTS :

1. For the students availing own transport, the parents are requested to adhere to the given timing to pick and drop their ward.
2. Parents/ guardians must escort their child to and from the school Gate.
3. Parents/ guardians must not leave their child unattended in the vehicle or at the school gate.

OWN VEHICLE (PRIVATE TRANSPORT)

RULES & REGULATIONS

The school rules and regulations are aimed at presenting the general functioning of SHSSS to all students, teacher, parents and staff members in order to ensure discipline and smooth functioning of the school. To achieve this goal, everyone must fully respect the rules and contribute through responsible daily behavior

The school campus is sacrosanct and must be respected accordingly by words and action. The school flag, its crest, the emblem, its uniform, its books and stationery are also sacrosanct. The uniform must be worn with pride. old crested items are not to be given as hand me downs. Abuse of any of the above, in any form, will be tantamount to violation of rules and regulations.

PRINCIPAL'S MEETING WITH PARENTS

The Principal will receive visitors and parents only on Friday and working Saturday from 10:00 am to 11:00 am or by prior appointment. No school matters will be transacted beyond school hours.

TEACHER'S MEETING WITH THE PARENTS

The best time to meet the concerned teacher is during parent teacher meeting. Parents are requested not to insist meeting a teacher during the school working hours. For any urgent concerns, an appointment must be sought through a written application addressed to the class teacher/coordinator.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- (1) The medium of instruction in school is English. All are strictly advised to speak in ENGLISH.
- (2) Students must come in proper and neat uniform every day.
- (3) Students should keep quiet while lining up in single file, with girls in the front and boys at the rear, for morning assemblies and while proceeding to special rooms.
- (4) Students should enter their classrooms immediately when the bell rings.
- (5) Students should address their teachers and all other members of teaching and non-teaching staff with due respect and politeness. They are expected to behave always in a proper manner, befitting the dignity of the school.
- (6) Students should not remain in their classrooms after dispersal without permission.
- (7) All lights, fans and air-conditioners should be switched off before students leave the classroom.
- (8) Running along corridors and staircases or making unnecessary noises is strictly forbidden.
- (9) Students must not enter other classrooms without teacher's permission.
- (10) Food and drinks can only be consumed in permitted areas only.

- (11) Students should keep the campus clean and tidy, taking care of school property.
- (12) Any willful damage done to school property, scribbling on furniture, walls, doors, or any other misconduct will not be tolerated and fine Rs. 5000/- will be imposed to compensate the damage.
- (13) Mobile phones, I-pods, cameras or any other expensive items are not permissible inside the school. If brought, these things will be confiscated. School will not be responsible for any articles lost.
- (14) No books, periodicals or news paper of any objectionable nature shall be brought to school.
- (15) No watches are allowed till class V. Class VI onwards only simple watches can be worn. No smart watches are allowed.
- (16) Student must bring their School Diary, text books, note books and a rough note book every day to the school.
- (17) All the belongings should be clearly labeled with name, class and section.
- (18) Birthdays can be celebrated by distributing fruits in the class only. Anything other than that will be sent back home.
- (19) 80% attendance is required to sit for the Annual Examination for promotion to the next class.
- (20) If any extra-curricular event clash with the school examination, consideration will be made.
- (21) Adoption of unfair means in any examination will result in the annulment of the student's entire term result.
- (22) Love of motherland comes first always and every time.
- (23) Due respect to the National Flag, National Anthem, National Song and School Anthem.
- (24) Due respect and obedience to parents, teachers and elders.
- (25) Good care of health and physical fitness.
- (26) Keen interest in studies.
- (27) Decency in talking and general behaviour. Always keen to, display social etiquettes and good manners.
- (28) Co-operation with parents, brothers and sisters at home and with teachers and school mates at school.
- (29) Inculcation of truthfulness as an integral part of one's personality.
- (30) Kindness to all, cruelty to none.
- (31) Shun temptation to vice of any kind.
- (32) Belief in the equality and brotherhood of all castes and creeds.
- (33) Feeling of pride in wearing the school uniform.
- (34) Maintenance of cleanliness and orderliness in the school premises.
- (35) Inculcation of habits like punctuality and regularity in every sphere of life.
- (36) Abhorrence of cheating and using unfair means in the examination.
- (37) Spirit of appreciation and respect for all religions.

PARENTAL COOPERATION

- (1) Parents are requested to read the contents of this diary and fill in all relevant information in the interest of their child and abide by the rules laid down by the school.
- (2) Your ward should carry his/her diary to school daily and all correspondence should be duly signed by you.
- (3) You must check your wards diary everyday. Any note from the teachers and circular columns should be duly countersigned by you.
- (4) We insist that parents should monitor their wards homework and other activities at home.
- (5) Children should be encouraged to self-help for work and study. Private tuition are strongly discouraged.
- (6) When communicating with the Principal, parents are requested to mention in their letters, the name, class and section of their child. If it relates to the siblings studying in different classes, two separate letters should be given.
- (7) Parents are requested to whole heartedly cooperate in the school events and functions.
- (8) It is mandatory for parents to attend parent teacher meetings
- (9) Any change in the address/ telephone number / guardian status must be immediately brought to the notice of the school office through a written application for necessary change in the records.
- (10) Complete medical record should be submitted in case your ward has a medical concern/condition.
- {11) If a student gets injured during school hours, first aid will be administered in the school infirmary and parents would be promptly informed.
- (12) Parents should ensure that their ward carries his / her tiffin and other, things required in school. We would not accept any item sent through drivers, servants or friends during working hours due to security reasons. If the child has not brought the tiffin it will be provided from the school canteen, the bill of the same will have to be cleared by the child the next day.
- (13) Criticisms of teachers or of the school in children's presence should be avoided.
- (14) If parents have any suggestion to make, Principal will be too happy to receive them through written communication, email or personally.
- (15) Any rude, abusive language or mis-behaviour used towards any member of the school, either directly or over the phone, through mails or otherwise, will be taken seriously by the school and will invite strong disciplinary action.

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

In case of disregard or disrespect of the rules and regulations of SHSSS, the following actions will be deemed necessary:

- The teacher will remind the student of the rule with a verbal warning to avoid repetition.
- The teacher can decide to inform the parents through a note in the diary.
- Teacher-student-principal discussion with a warning letter or a note sent to the parents.

- The parents will be requested for a meeting with the teacher or principal or the administration and necessary action will be taken like temporary suspension from school.
- If student continues to display similar behavior with respect to the school rules and regulations, the student is deemed unacceptable resulting in the expulsion by the school administration.

WARNING CARDS

Warning card will be given to a student when and if required. Warning Card : For indiscipline, irregular or late attendance, lack of proper outfit and school equipment, for neglect of daily lessons, frequent omission of home work. For insolence, stealing, copying in examination or a test.

Three warning cards carry a Red Card.

WITHDRAWALS :

Three month's notice in writing should be given by the parents before withdrawing a student from the school, otherwise fee for the 3 months will be charged. A school leaving certificate will be issued only if all dues have been paid.

A Red card means serious action will be taken against the concerned student.

SECURITY OF CHILDREN AT SHSSS

Safety and security of students from the time of arrival till they leave the school premises.

- Staff is in place to attend to children coming in early. **School gates will only be opened at 07:30 a.m. in summer and 08:30 a.m. in winter.**
- Children are assembled at designated areas and kept under the strict watch of the staff.
- Teachers escort the students to their classes.
- Attendance is marked each time the class returns from an activity and after recess.
- Ahead count of students is done regularly in the junior classes.
- In the senior school, attendance is taken at the beginning of each period.
- Absentee proforma is filled - SMS are sent to the parents of absentees on a daily basis.
- Regular Snake Checks of the premises, especially the fields and green areas are conducted.
- Mobiles are banned for the students. If any student is found with the mobile, it will be confiscated and fine of Rs. 5000/- will be charged.
- First aid protocols are affixed at important points all around the school.
- Each classroom is equipped with a basic first aid box. Expiry of all medications is regularly checked.
- Special care is taken of the students who are allergic, diabetic or having any other

health issues.

- During Dengue/Swine flu season we instruct our students to wear full sleeves and long trousers especially in junior school.
- Surprise checks of students' bags are conducted by authorized people.
- PTI's are on duty at the time when sport academies are on -before and after school hours.
- OTG Facility is given to the students to reheat the lunch.
- There is one attendant per washroom at all times.
- Maids and support staff accompany the junior school on outdoor trips.
- Strict segregation of areas during the break time for children and staff is on duty.
- No vendors are allowed onto the premises during school hours.
- Teachers strictly adhere to the "No Meeting" policy during the school hours.
- Taking the safety and security of our children further, regular health checks are conducted. No child is allowed to leave the class without the permission card issued by the teacher.
- A Four tier system is in place for a child leaving before time. Diary note to be signed by the Class Teacher, the Coordinator, the School Reception and Checked at the gate.
- Students are escorted personally by the teachers to exit points at the time of school closing

BUS SAFETY

- CCTV, GPRS and Speed governors have been installed in all the buses.
- The School has specially purchased an Alcohol Meter. Regular testing of the bus staff takes place and is recorded. A zero tolerance policy to alcohol consumption is in place.
- Bus dispersal forms are filled daily by the teachers before the bus leaves.
- Students are seated in pre-assigned seats. Attendance is taken and is duly checked by the school authorities before the buses leave. Buses park in a "Vehicle Free Zone" at the time of embarkation to ensure the safety of the children from the traffic in the car park area.
- Students taking half day and/or not availing the bus service for the day need special permission for the same. **Police verification of all School Personnel.**
- Police verification of the teaching staff, members of the administrative block, computer staff, and grade D staff is undertaken.
- All the drivers and bus attendants are verified.
- All contractual staff is hired only after thorough background check and identity verification through Voter card or Aadhar card etc. Police verification is also carried out for such staff.

INSTALLATION OF CCTV CAMERAS

- CCTV cameras have been installed and constant checks are conducted to ensure their proper working.
- Camera recordings are monitored regularly by the school authorities.

WASHROOMS

- Renovated washrooms, updated with modern amenities have been provided for the students at every floor of the school building and are regularly checked by the designated staff.

IMPORTANT NOTE :

A student having come to school and is present in the class for a period/periods and then bunks or a student having started for school from home is found to be roaming anywhere instead of being present in the school, in either case the said student is liable to summary dismissal from the school. A warning will be issued to a student, found guilty of serious breach of discipline e.g. grave negligence regarding studies, misbehaviour inside and outside the school etc. by the Principal. After due warning, such a student will be dismissed from the school.

PROMOTIONS:

1. Pupils who miss any test shall not be re-tested.
2. A student, if absent in any one of the test will not be given any position. The same applies for any student joining in between the session.
3. A student failing in the term examinations will not be promoted to the next class.
4. No test/exam shall be held before or after the due date under any circumstances.
5. A minimum of 80% attendance will be required for promotion in the next class.
6. Pupils whose fees are not paid in full will not be allowed to sit in for the final examination.
7. Result declared at the end of the year is final.
8. A student who fails twice in the same class will not be permitted to continue his studies in the school.

ENTRY INTO THE SCHOOL PREMISES MUST BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECURITY NORMS.

- Entry of persons/vehicles is recorded at the school gates by the security agency guards.
- Entry is not given to any vehicle without the permission and sticker/proper verification.
- Entry to the school building is strictly restricted and guarded.
- An efficient communication system is in place between the school reception and the security personnel on duty at school gate.
- All visitors are required to fill in the "PERMISSION SLIP" proforma. One is handed over to the reception and a carbon copy of the same is retained at the gate.
- Visitors must wear a visitor's card around their necks for the entire duration of their visit in the school and return it at the gate when they depart.
- Students will not be allowed to enter the school without wearing an ID Card.
- Strict protocol is in place to ensure that the drivers, attendants and other male support staff are not given unrestricted access to the school building during school hours.
- Specific areas for the above mentioned persons have been designated and separate toilets and water points have been allocated.

PROPERLY BUILT BOUNDARY WALL AND INFRASTRUCTURE.

- The school is adequately gated and secured with the help of boundary wall.
- CCTV cameras are in place and repair of the same are carried out at regular intervals"
- school audit for fire safety is conducted regularly and fire extinguishers are placed at strategic points.
- School is regularly checked for safety of the building and the certification for the same is in place.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Sacred Heart Sen. Sec. School is registered according to the Minority Act. It is a Christian and secular school open to boys and girls of all communities.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES :

The dates of payment should be noted carefully late fee charges of Rs. 10/- per day from 11th to 20th and Rs. 20/- per day from 21st to 30th of month and Rs. 50/- per day from 1st of next month to 15th. After 15th student's name will be struck off and Re-admission charges of Rs. 1000/- will be charged alongwith fine
3. All Fees etc. will be increased 10-15% every year.

Conveyance :

Arrangement for the conveyance of children exists for those who would like to avail.

RE-ADMISSION

The student whose name is struck off due to long absence or non-payment of dues till the last date of the concerned month can be readmitted on application of request by the parents with re-admission fees of Rs. 1000/- in addition to dues and arrears.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

The school holds three periodic tests in addition to Half Yearly and Annual Examination during the year as per CBSE pattern. Pupils who miss any test will not be retested. Average marks will be awarded only in case of illness for which a medical certificate must be provided along with a written application. There can be no advance - conducting or postponement of any test. Students who are all ill should not be sent to take the test. Such cases will be decided on merit on the basis of regular progress. Promotions are granted on the basis of Periodic Tests, Half yearly and Annual Examination. Therefore regular attendance and work is imperative. Result declared at the end of the year is final in all cases and will not be reconsidered.

- A clean handkerchief to be carried daily.
- Sleeves and socks should not be rolled up and buttons should not be left undone.
- Colored dress is allowed only on birthdays for Grade Nursery to 2 and on other occasions as and when announced by the school. Grade III onwards students are not allowed to wear colored dress on birthdays.
